WHAT IS WBL

WBL experiences offer students the opportunity to explore career options and develop critical academic and technical skills in collaboration with community and/or industry involvement.

Participating students will have a Personalized Learning Plan to address learning objectives related to specific skills in the following areas:

(a) the application of academic and technical knowledge and skills

(b) career knowledge and navigation skills

(c) 21st Century learning and innovation skills

(d) personal and social skills

• Students will exhibit work readiness knowledge, attitudes, and skills before beginning WBL experiences
